WITH a winemaking history dating back to 1838 and the Macarthur family, Robert Stein Wines has quite a heritage.

Johann Stein was brought to Australia with the first cuttings of Rhine Riesling, and the vines flourished under his careful watch.

The Stein name continues in the world of wine, after Bob Stein renewed the passion in 1976 with the purchase of 30ha at Mudgee. Today his son Drew and grandson Jacob produce wines of the 21st century, including the award winning 2009 Robert Stein Riesling.

An important part of the success with riesling in this part of the world is the role played by Jacob, having worked vintages in the most famous of riesling regions.

With a great fruit intensity the family has produced this fine wine, worthy of many more awards.
